- 2. **PROPRIETY** (pruh PRIE uh tee) (n.): the quality of behaving in a proper manner and obeying rules and customs. Synonyms: appropriateness; decorum; decency; modesty.
- 3. **PRUDENCE** (PROO dehns) (n.): wisdom, caution, or restraint. Synonym: discretion.
- 4. **PULCHRITUDE** (PUHL kruh tood) (n.): beauty, gorgeousness, loveliness.
- 5. **PUNGENT** (PUHN juhnt) (adj.): sharp and irritating to the senses.
- 6. QUERULOUS (KWEHR yoo luhs) (adj.): inclined to complain; irritable. Synonym: whiny.
- 7. QUOTIDIAN (kwo TIH dee uhn) (adj.): occurring daily; commonplace. Synonyms: usual; normal.
- 8. REDRESS (RIH drehs) (n.): relief from wrong or injury.

 Synonyms: reparation; restitution.
- 9. RETICENT (REH tih suhnt) (adj.): silent; reserved.

 Synonyms: introverted; laconic; taciturn; undemonstrative.
- 10. SACROSANCT (SAA kroh saankt) (adj.): extremely sacred;
 beyond criticism.
