1. SAGACIOUS (suh GAY shuhs) (adj.): shrewd; wise.
2. SALIENT (SAY lee uhnt) (adj.): prominent; of notable significance. Synonym: outstanding.
3. SALUBRIOUS (suh LOO bree uhs) (adj.): healthful; therapeutic.
4. SANGUINE (SAAN gwuhn) (adj.): cheerfully optimistic.
5. SARDONIC (sahr DAH nihk) (adj.): cynical; scornfully mocking. Synonym: sarcastic.
6. SATIATE (SAY shee ayt) (v.): to satisfy fully or to overindulge.
7. SERAPHIC (seh RAH fihk) (adj.): angelic; sweet.
8. SPARTAN (SPAHR tihn) (adj.): highly-disciplined; frugal; austere. Synonyms: restrained; simple.
9. STIGMA (STIHG mah) (n.): a mark of shame or discredit. Synonym: opprobrium.
10. STRATAGEM (STRAA tuh juhm) (n.): trick designed to deceive an enemy.
