

1. OROTUND (OR uh tuhnd) (adj.): pompous; bombastic; declamatory.
2. OPINE (oh PIEN) (v.): to express an opinion.
3. OPAQUE (oh PAYK) (adj.): impossible to see through; preventing the passage of light.
4. OBIVIATE (AHB vee ayt) (v): to prevent; to make unnecessary.
5. OBSEQUIOUS (uhb SEE kwee uhs) (adj.): overly submissive and eager to please, compliant.
6. OBSTINATE (AHB stih nuht) (adj.): stubborn; unyielding.
7. OBDURATE (AHB duhr uht) (adj.): hardened in feeling; resistant to persuasion.
8. PATHOGENIC (paa thoh JEHN ink): causing disease.
9. PENURY (PEHN yuh ree) (n.): an oppressive lack of resources (as money); severe poverty.
10. PEREGRINATE (PEH ruh gruh nayt) (v.): to wander from place to place; to travel, especially on foot.
