HOMEWORK

Homework will be uploaded onto Archie every Monday by 12pm. The entire packet should be printed on Monday and brought in daily in your child's Math folder (green folder). An informational sheet will be the cover of the homework packet. Please read it every Monday with your child; it contains information about the lessons as well as details about any tests for that week.

Homework packet must be turned in every Monday for a grade. Incomplete homework will be graded accordingly. Late homework is accepted with an excuse note for an absence. In case of an excused absence, students have 3 days to make up missed homework and class work.

ASSESSMENTS

Test dates will be informed on the cover page of the homework packet and an email will be sent as a reminder 48 hours before the test date.
