My name is Ms. Maria and I will be your child's 4th grade American Math teacher. I will communicate regularly about our Mathematics agenda, your child's progress and other activities that will arise in my class via email. I ask that you help by promoting a positive and active role in your child's education. If you ever have any questions or concerns throughout the school year, please feel free to e-mail me at morales.zervos@archimedean.org.

Students are required to write in their journal on a daily basis. We review pertinent Math vocabulary and complete examples regularly. If a child fails to complete the required classwork, they will be unable to complete the assigned homework and will receive an incomplete for the day.

Home learning is an integral part of your child's education. **Homework** supplements and reinforces work done in school. In addition, it fosters student initiative, independence, and responsibility and brings home and school closer together. Students will be assigned a homework packet at the beginning of each week. The homework packet will be uploaded on the Archimedean website every Monday morning (sis.archimedean.org).

Homework will be corrected in class on a daily basis. The completed homework packet will be collected the following Monday for a letter grade. If your child fails to complete homework for any given day, their grade will drop by one letter each day. If a homework packet is not turned in, the student will receive an incomplete.

In addition to the homework packet, I will assign activities on various math websites throughout the year. Students will receive login information for these websites during the first few weeks of school. Please check your child's agenda and homework packet to ensure all assignments are complete.

ThinkCentral is a web-based program I use in conjunction with my weekly lesson which helps students review lessons. Homework packets will explain in detail when Think Central activities will be assigned.

ReflexMath is yet another web-based program available to help review multiplication and division facts. Please keep in mind, the 4th Grade Mathematics Curriculum depends on a **STRONG** foundation in multiplication and division. Concepts to be covered include multi-digit multiplication and division, factorization, fractions, and area. Students must be fluent in all multiplication and division facts. These skills were introduced in 2nd grade and should have been mastered in 3rd grade. If your child has not mastered their multiplication and division facts, please encourage your child to use this program daily.

Various projects will be assigned throughout the year to help reinforce the lesson at hand.

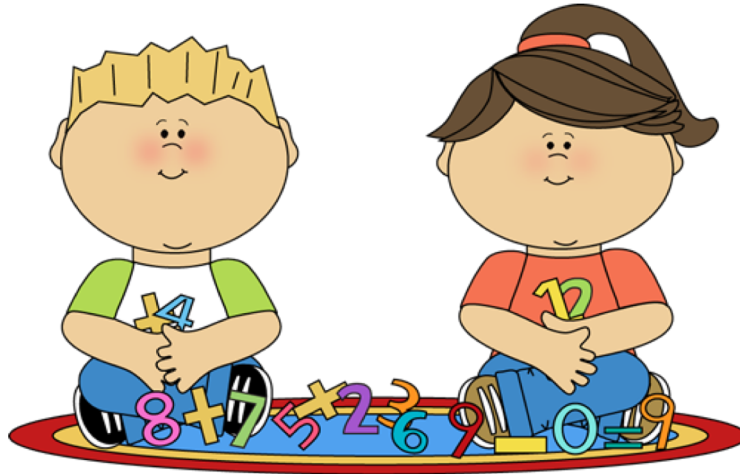
Students will be given weekly assessments and they will be returned the following week so you can review mistakes with your child.

Student Login Instructions

Click 'Launch' in the upper right hand corner of the page.

Login using the teacher username, class and password information explained below.

If your child has not mastered their multiplication/division facts, the Reflex website can help! The Reflex system combines research-proven methods and innovative technology to provide the most effective math fact fluency solution available. Multiple studies have demonstrated the importance of fluency in achieving broader success in mathematics. As students log in to the program, they are given a certain number of facts to answer correctly on a given day. When the goal is achieved, a Green Light illuminates in the upper right corner of the screen. This indicates that the student has met the Daily Usage Requirement.

Since Reflex includes fun games, your child's siblings or friends may want to play. It is important other children not use your child's account. Reflex continually monitors student progress and adapts to each student's individual need.

Signing up for a free Reflex Parent Reporting Account is easy:

3. Launch Reflex and log in.

Once you are logged in, click the 'Add Student' button and follow the onscreen directions.
