

Speech 4 T-arms

Task: You must create a speech about the topic in your assigned article (from the article homework) that demonstrates 2 out of the 3 following aspects:

- The speaker establishes credibility & trustworthiness
- The speech exhibits logical reasoning and evidence (testimony, facts, figures, etc.)
- The speaker makes an emotional connection with the audience

Additional requirements:

All Students MUST Type the Speech

You must type and print your speech and bring it to class

All Students MUST Present the Speech WITHOUT the Typed Paper in Front of Them

You will have to present your speech WITHOUT the typed paper in front of you. You can have a single index card (5"x3" maximum) with information on THE FRONT but it cannot be your speech that you will be reading.

NOTE: YOU WILL NOT BE GRADED ON MEMORIZING YOUR SPEECH WORD FOR WORD.

So long as the speech you give follows the points from your typed speech, you will be meeting expectations.

All Students MUST Present Doing the T-arms

This exercise is used in order to make you mindful of your posture. Keep your arms stretched out to the sides and don't sway while speaking. You will have to turn your head to look at the audience.



All Students MAY have an image to be projected
