

Speech 5: Great Ideas

Task: You must create a speech which focuses on one of the six great ideas (Truth, Goodness, Beauty, Justice, Fairness, Equality). You must present your speech in such a way that you make your audience care about your speech. Your speech doesn't explicitly have to be about the great idea (for example, you can tell a story, persuade the audience about something, inform them about something they don't know, etc), but the great idea must be underlying the speech you present.

Duration: The speech must be less than 3 minutes.

Expectations:

1. Focus on one major idea.
2. Give people a reason to care.
3. Build your idea with familiar concepts.
4. Make your idea worth sharing.
