Instructions:

Independently, actively, and analytically read The Great Gatsby by Frances Scott Fitzgerald. For each Gatsby chapter (there are 9), provide descriptions and/or explanations of the following elements:

1. Setting(s)
2. Key Events
3. Psychological time (if applicable)
4. Conflicts
5. Main character descriptions and analyses
6. Symbolism
7. Figurative/poetic language
8. New vocabulary (provide word, page #, and appropriate definition)
9. Favorite quotes (1 from each chapter)
10. Themes
11. Personal reflection

Tips:

- Annotate while you read so that you may use your annotations later for your chapter assignment.
- Complete your work chapter by chapter rather than all together at the end of the novel. Advantages: 1) Chapter content will still be fresh in your mind. 2) The overall work will seem less daunting if you complete it in chunks.

Additional Notes:

- **On Style:** Your assignment must be typed using Times New Roman or Spectral font in size 12. I suggest you work on a google document.
- **Bonus:** You may turn in a Gatsby-inspired illustration or original piece of art for extra credit.
