To inform schools that Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work® Day will be observed in Miami-Dade County Public Schools on Friday, February 1, 2019, instead of the national date of April 25, 2019.

- ⌚ For more than 20 years, individuals, families, organizations, and workplaces have joined in this day to expand opportunities and to transform the lives of millions of girls and boys around the world.
- ⌚ This nationally recognized program encourages boys and girls ages 8-18 to accompany their parents, mentors, or guardians to work.
- ⌚ Spending a day at the workplace with parents or other adults provides hands-on, interactive experience and allows students to connect their classroom education to the work world.

SCHOOL GUIDELINES:

- ⌚ Schools should provide an official "FIELD TRIP" form (FM #2431) for students who want to participate in this activity.
- ⌚ Field trip forms should be completed before the day of the activity. We encourage schools to set a deadline for returning these forms to the school. This will avoid calls from parents on the day of the activity.
- ⌚ We encourage schools to plan classroom activities that will help students maximize their workplace experience. Teachers and other educators are encouraged to visit www.daughtersandsonstowork.org.
- ⌚ Parents and guardians who are considering participating in Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work® Day are encouraged to gauge the age and maturity of their children. Parents should make advance arrangements with their employers to ensure that activities will be safe and meaningful.
- ⌚ Please check with your principal, as school guidelines and student participation criteria may vary among schools.
