The purpose of the project is:

- 1) to understand the effect of the Greek language on English.
- 2) to create a useful book/vocabulary for subsequent students to understand the importance of Greek for English and to increase their motivation to learn the language.
- 3) to learn more easily some Greek words that are also used in English.

Procedure:

- 1) Create a file like [THIS](#), name this file (for example Brianna-Gianna), save to Google Drive and share this file with me (tdarvoudis@gmail.com). You have to do this today (2/21/19) and start to write the words.
- 2) Choose the most common and interesting words used in everyday life, in school or in science. Write the Greek word and its meaning in one column and in the second column write the most important English words that come from the Greek word. Think of the pupil's perspective. What will be more interesting and attractive to students. Andres & Cristian will write Prefixes and Suffixes. Nicole, Maria & Tatiana will write the introduction.

Each team must write about 100 words in Greek and 200-500 derived words in English. What is more important is not the number of words, but the right choice of the best words. We should end this record until next Friday (3/1/19). If you think is good for a word to be explained you can use a hyperlink to <https://www.etymonline.com> or <https://www.merriam-webster.com/> like the word [ANDROID](#).

- 3) The next phase will be to classify the words into categories. (e.g. science and school subject, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Medicine, Politics, Economy, Literature/Theater, Mythology, Music, Theology, etc.). This is the next phase, but as you choose the words think also about the possible category.

Grading: You will have a grade for homework and a grade for participation each week. And you will have a test grade plus a quiz grade for your final product.

You will have a homework grade today. You had to create your file, to share with me and write at least the first 5 Greek words and the derived English. So, share your file with me until tonight.

You will have a participation grade for tomorrow class work.
