but has a brain that's extra small.

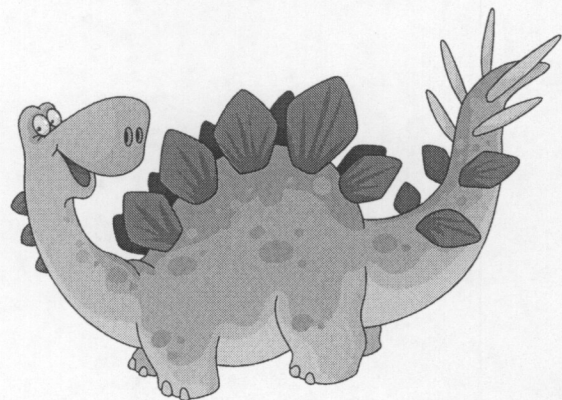
He's not the brightest dinosaur.

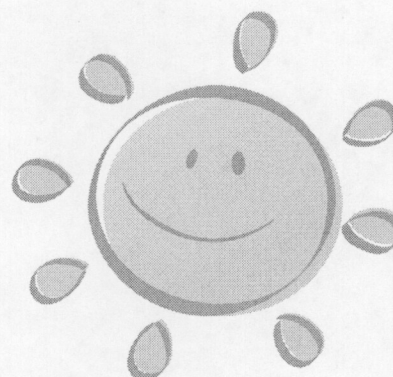

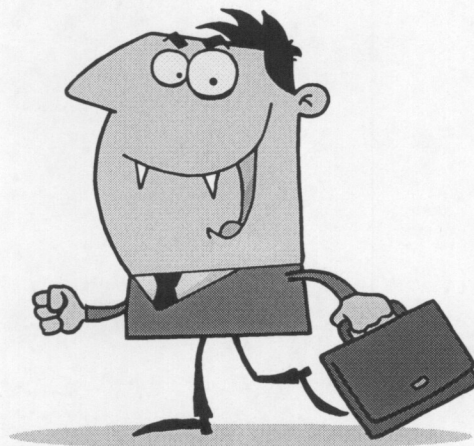
