Do you see our tan van?

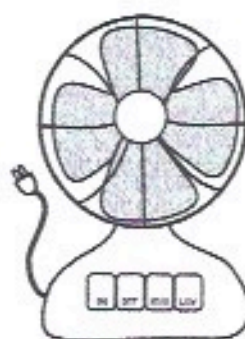
It can get hot in our tan van.
