She is my perfect puppy.

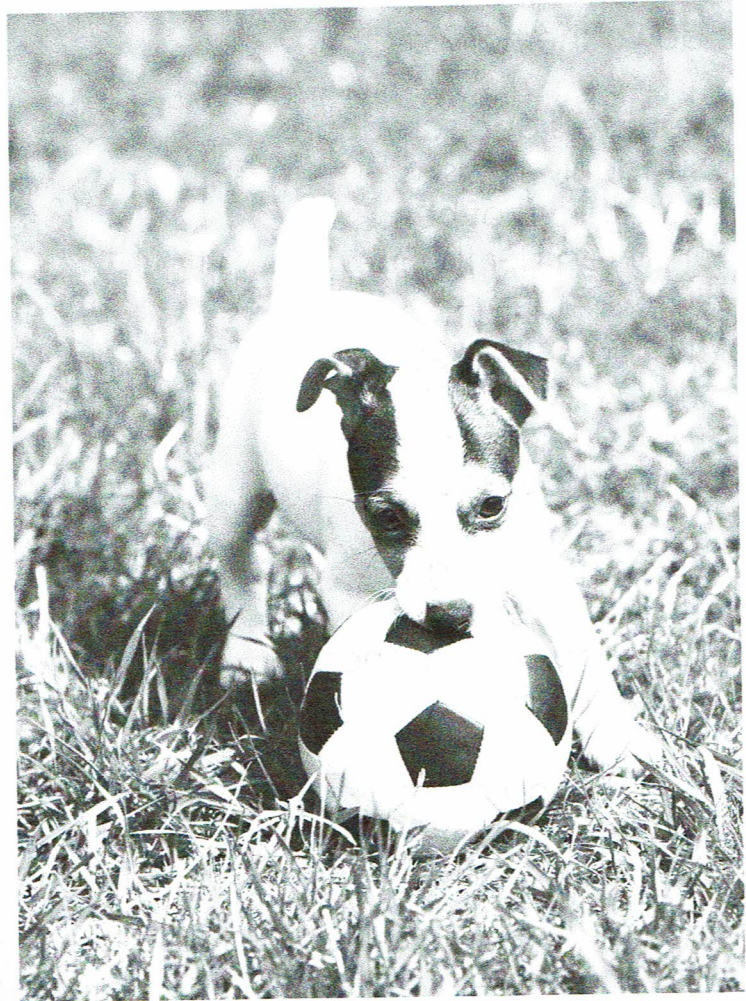
Each day I think of her

The Sneaky Snuggly Kitten

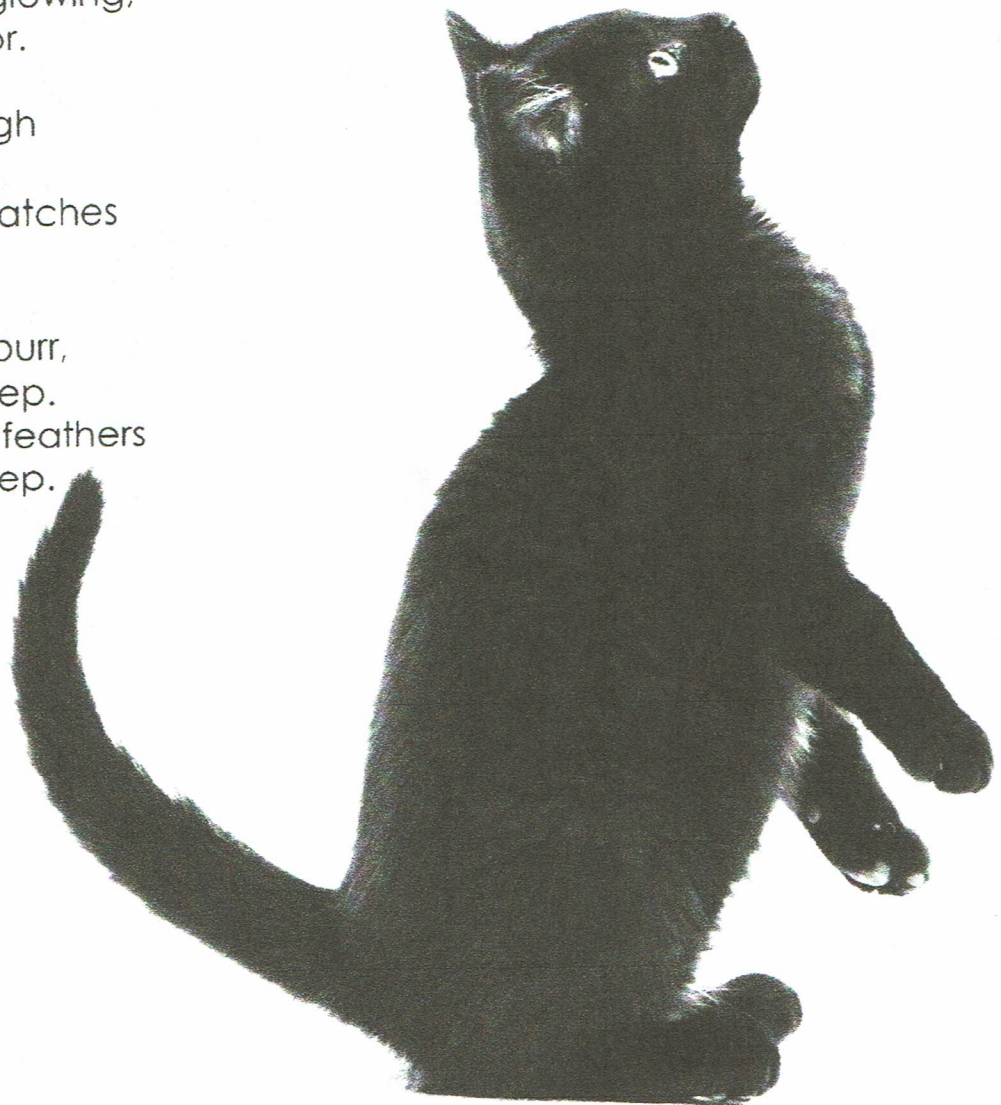
Early in the morning,
