- ⊗ Stars are big balls of burning gases. (Hydrogen + Helium)
- ⊗ There are more stars in the sky than we can easily count.
- ⊗ Stars are scattered evenly in the sky.
- ⊗ Stars are always in the sky, even during the day, but we can't see them because the sun is too bright.
- ⊗ Stars have different sizes and colors. (white, yellow, red, blue)
- ⊗ The sun is a star.
- ⊗ The sun is the star that is closest to Earth.
- ⊗ Gravity is a force that pulls objects towards each other.
- ⊗ Earth's gravity makes all objects fall to the ground.
