### **TOPIC: MUSICAL STYLES – ROCK**

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#### **STEP 1: Complete Cinemath Lesson 4**

- 1.** Watch my Lesson 4 on Cinemath and take notes from it.
- 2.** In this lesson you will learn the following:
  - Rock songs have a number of basic elements: a rock drum rhythm, three simple chords, a repeated lyric about something you care about, verses (A), and a chorus (B).
  - Rock uses microphones and amplified instruments so music is louder and reaches a bigger audience.
  - Rock bands commonly employ: a lead singer, drummer, electric guitarist or two, and an electric bass player.
  - Rock music has a strong, heavily accented, driving meter of 4.
  - Rock music has developed into many separate rock styles including punk, grunge, heavy metal, pop rock, pop, folk rock, and country rock.
