 - Rock bands commonly employ: a lead singer, drummer, electric guitarist or two, and an electric bass player.
 - Rock music has a strong, heavily accented, driving meter of 4.
 - Rock music has developed into many separate rock styles including punk, grunge, heavy metal, pop rock, pop, folk rock, and country rock.
