

Study notes on the Greek nouns on the Singular number -2nd grade.

In the Greek language class we are working on the Greek nouns. All **nouns** are classified in three groups as **masculine, feminine and neutral**, according to their endings. They are used in singular, or in plural number.

Second graders will learn the singular and the plural numbers. Also, we are learning the definite articles (**ο, η, το**) and the indefinite articles (**ένας,μια,ένα**) and how we are using them.

The following table exemplify the different groups.

We will have a Test on the Greek nouns **-Singular number-** on Thursday ,December 9,2021. Scholars will be asked to write the correct definite articles (ο,η,το) and the indefinite articles (ένας,μια,ένα) in front of a set of nouns, depending of the endings of the nouns.

Please use the study guide to review with your child the 3 groups of nouns their articles and their endings.
