Study notes on the Greek nouns on the Singular number -2nd grade.

In the Greek language class we are working on the Greek nouns. All **nouns** are classified in three groups as **masculine**, **feminine** and **neutral**, according to their endings. They are used in singular, or in plural number.

Second graders will learn the singular and the plural numbers. Also, we are learning the definite articles (o, n, τo) and the indefinite articles ($\dot{\epsilon} \nu \alpha \varsigma$, $\mu \alpha$, $\dot{\epsilon} \nu \alpha$) and how we are using them.

The following table exemplify the different groups.
