

Make a Map: Mythology and the Pre-Socratics

Instructions: Create a map that contains southern Italy, Greece, Crete and western Turkey (see below). This map must include the following locations:

- A. The birthplace of Thales, Anaximander and Anaximenes
- B. The birthplace of Xenophanes
- C. The birthplace of Heraclitus
- D. The birthplace of Parmenides and Zeno
- E. The site of the war depicted in Homer's Iliad
- F. The home city of Menelaus
- G. The home city of Agamemnon
- H. The island ruled by Odysseus
- I. The site where the stone that Kronos thought was Zeus is placed
- J. The island where Zeus was hidden as a child

These locations should be labeled on your map with the letter above (A-J), and the proper name (whatever it is). You may include a legend to do this or label the map directly.

This map may be created physically (on a piece of paper with art supplies) or digitally (in whatever drawing/art program you wish). I require **TWO** copies:

- ❖ IF: you made it on a piece of paper, 1) give me the original and 2) take a picture and upload it
- ❖ IF: you made it digitally, 1) upload the file and 2) print out a copy and give it to me

I will grade this map according to the following **rubric**:

- 50% The above locations are properly labeled and placed in the correct locations on the map
- 20% The map represents the correct geographic area and is easily visually readable
- 30% The map is artistically decorated, uses color, and beautifully uses phrases, symbols and/or other means to add tasteful flavor and information to the map in general and the locations in particular
