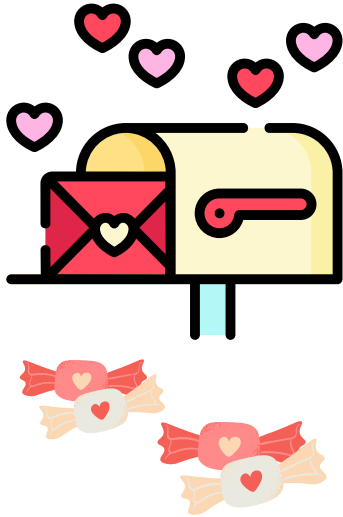


VALENTINE'S MAILBOX PROJECT



Dear Parents,

As a home project, the students will need to create a homemade mailbox for this year's Valentine's Day for the cards and candy exchange that will be taking place on Tuesday, February 14th, 2023. The mailbox can be created from a shoebox wrapped and decorated using a Valentine's theme. On top of the mailbox, a large slit should be made wide enough for the cards and candy to fit safely inside. Please help your child with their creativity. You can use ribbon, glitter, Valentine's stickers, pom-poms, wrapping paper, yarn, etc.! Please do not use food or candy to decorate the mailbox.

This project is due Tuesday, February 14th, 2023.

On Tuesday, February 14th, we are also asking students to bring in Valentine cards and wrapped candy (**no candy or chocolate containing peanuts or home made treats**) for their classmates (**no candy will be eaten in class**). Please have your child sign each card WITHOUT addressing them to individual students (Ex: To My Friend). This will help your child distribute the cards easily and quickly.

In addition, on Valentine's day, students are allowed to wear a Valentine's themed shirt or a colored shirt that is red, white or pink.
