

An introduction should have:

- A hook - a sentence that grabs the audience's attention with something interesting
- Background Information - something we need to know going into the paper
- Thesis - your stance that answers the question and an allusion to your 2-3 reasons

You will submit the draft of your initial draft of the introduction, the comments made by your classmate on what was done well and what was done poorly, and the changes you made to fix the intro.

Once done, start working on the first body paragraph.
