1. Plug your device into power and connect to your home Wi-Fi.
2. Go to Settings > General, then tap Software Update.
3. Follow prompts to update.

C) Please send your child's headphones if you have not done so yet.

D) Sweaters may be needed as classes are cold.

E) Good night sleep the night before.

F) Good morning breakfast the day of the test.
