4. Tell us how the people from your country settled in America. What's the story?
5. Tell us about cultural outfits. Show us! (You can email me pictures and I can project it.)
6. Interview someone to ask them questions about their heritage. Share with us your findings.
7. Give us a Spanish lesson. Maybe share with us some words that are different among the various hispanic countries.
