

Short Film “Extinguished” Dialogue Assignment

1. Watch the video: How to Write Better Dialogue in 8 Minutes
2. Watch the film “Extinguished” at least twice.
3. For this assignment you will be writing the dialogue for the short film “Extinguished.” Your dialogue must be typed and in screenplay format. You can see the screenplay format in the first video. It is the text that is being edited. The character’s name should be in the center of the page and their dialogue should be in a block paragraph beneath their name.

Requirements:

Your work must be typed in Times New Roman 12pt font and double spaced.

You must include both internal and external dialogue.

External dialogue is usually two people talking, but it can also be more than two people. External dialogue is what the characters say out loud.

Internal dialogue: Internal dialogue is a character’s inner voice. In storytelling, internal dialogue serves the role of communicating unspoken thoughts and feelings to the audience.

You must write at least 750 words. (The equivalent of 3 free writes)

This will count as a test grade.
