**OPINION**

**EXAMPLES**

**Text Organization**

**Description**

Informational texts have a structure, or type of organization, that fits the topic and the author's purpose.

Description is one kind of structure or organization. Authors choose description to tell details about *what something is like*.

Examples

- It smells like...
- It looks like...
- It sounds like...
- It feels like...
- It acts like...

**RETELL**

When you retell, you describe what happens in a story in order.

Beginning

FIRST... NEXT... THEN... LAST... End

**TIPS**

- Use your own words.
- Use words and pictures.

**SETTING**

**WHERE**

Where does the story happen?

**WHEN**

When does the story take place?

Ask yourself, "Why is the setting important to the story?"


