2. Neighbors have the right to decide what kind of community they want to have – including who lives in that neighborhood.
3. You can't put a price on self-respect; I would not trade my dignity just to make life easier.
4. Most people don't try hard enough to see the other people's problems.
5. I see the effects of racism and other forms of prejudice in my everyday life.
6. If I were to move to a new school with a very different culture, I would try to fit in, even if it meant changing my appearance, music preferences, or speech patterns to feel more comfortable.

7. Thinking of your ancestors and cultural heritage is a waste of time. It doesn't make a difference where my ancestors came from, it only matters where I am now.
8. Hopes and dreams can make you miserable; it is better to accept your life as is and just try to make the best of it.
9. When someone insults you, it's best to "turn the other cheek."
