

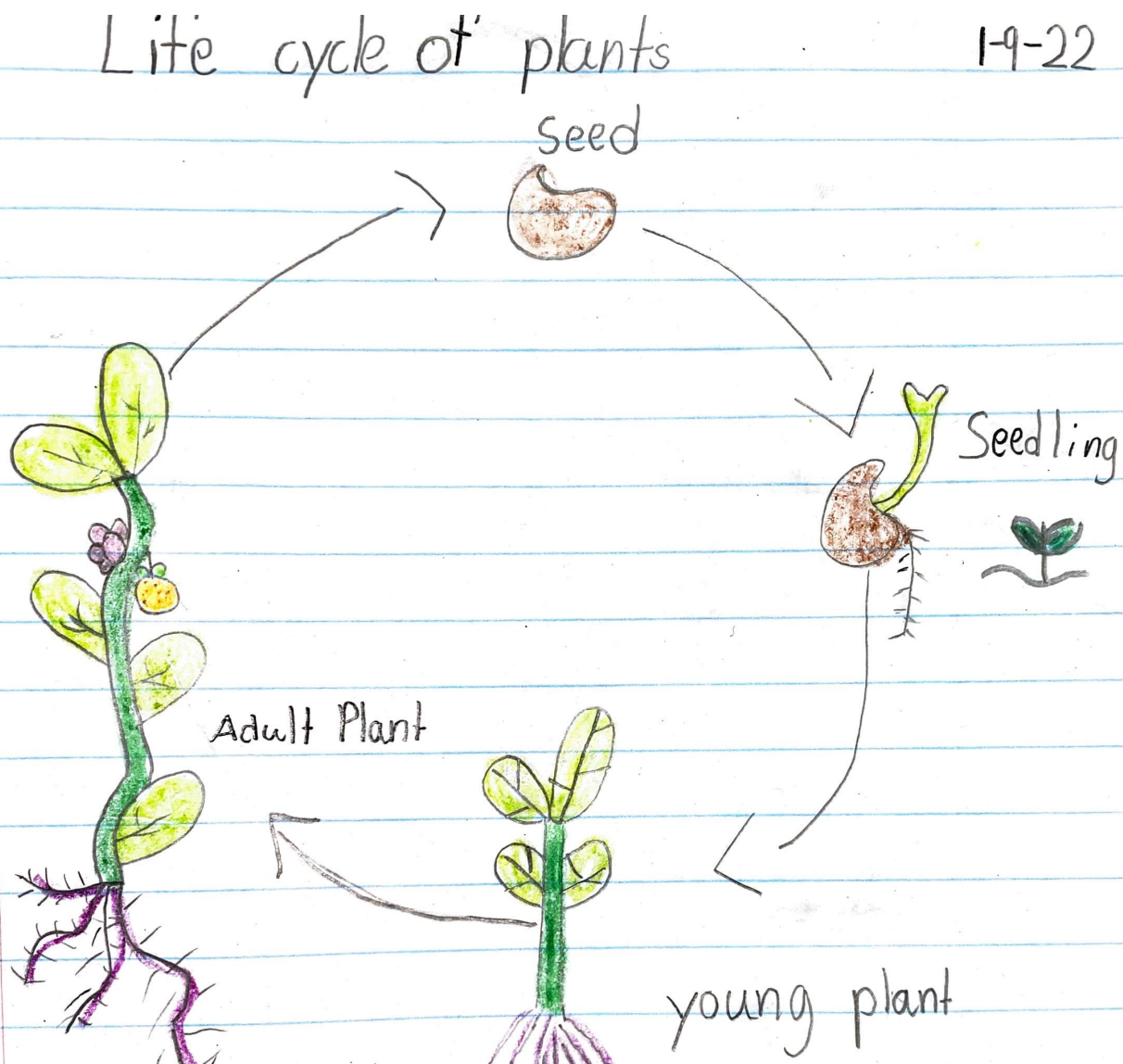
Plant Life Cycle Study Guide

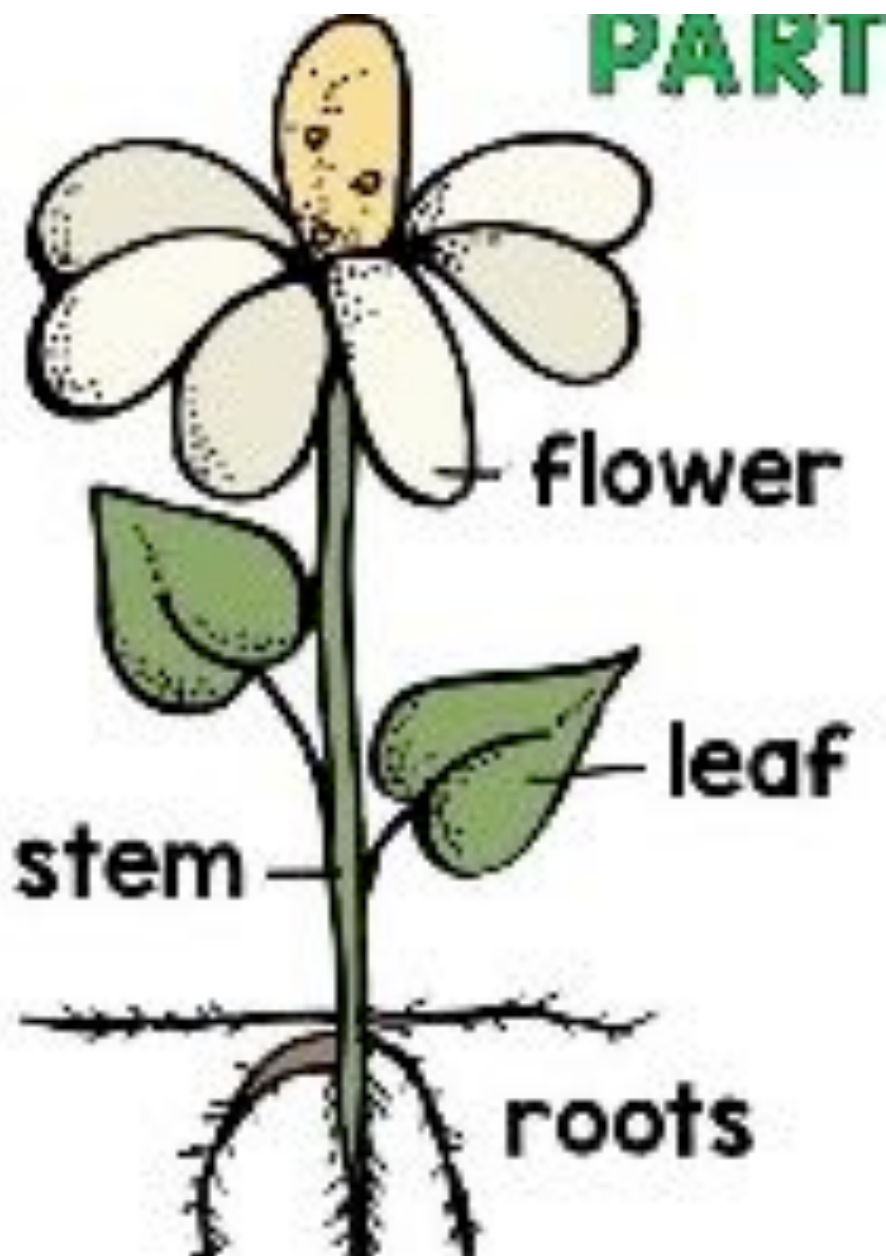
Vocabulary

- **Seed:** A small embryonic plant enclosed in a covering called a seed coat, usually with some stored food.
- **Stem:** Part of the plant that gives support and carries water, minerals, and food throughout the plant.
- **Pollen:** The sticky powder inside the flower inside the flower that helps make the seeds.
- **Leaves:** Part of a plant that absorbs sunlight and helps make food for the plant.
- **Roots :** Part of the plant that absorbs water water and minerals from the soil.

FACTS:

- Plants can make their own food.
- Plants need sunlight, water, and soil to grow.
- Some plants can grow in the dark.
- Plants need insects to grow.
