This week we will learn to read the vowel combinations «αυ» and «ευ». The vowel combinations of «αυ» and «ευ» have a double pronunciation. This means that in some words they are pronounced as /av/ and /ev/ and in some others as /af/ and /ef/:

- The “αυ” and “ευ” are pronounced as /av/ and /ev/ when a vowel or a voiced consonant follows (β, γ, δ, ζ, λ, μ, ν, ρ).
- They pronounced as af and ef when a voiceless consonant follows (κ, π, τ, χ, φ, θ, σ, ξ, ψ).

We will also learn how to write the days of the week.
