

# Texture

## What is Texture?

Texture refers to how something feels, including its appearance and consistency (LOOK and FEEL). Glass, wood, rock and sand all have different textures, and words that we use to describe texture include rough, smooth, soft, and glossy.

## What are the different types of texture in art?

**Actual (or physical) texture:** refers to the tactile qualities of a material or piece of art.

**Implied (or visual) texture:** concerns the textural appearance of a 2D artwork.
