The cat looked out the window.

## Being Verbs

Some verbs do not show action. The verbs *am*, *is*, *are*, *was*, and *were* are forms of the verb *be*. They tell what someone or something is or was. *Am*, *is*, and *are* show present tense. *Was* and *were* show past tense.

I am happy to be here.

They are good friends.

You were the first person I met.
