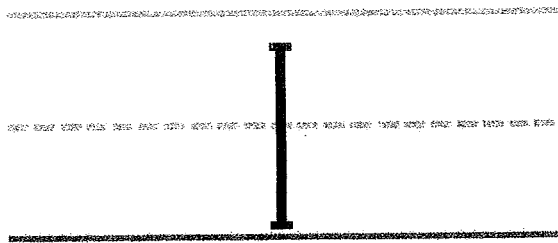

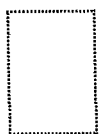

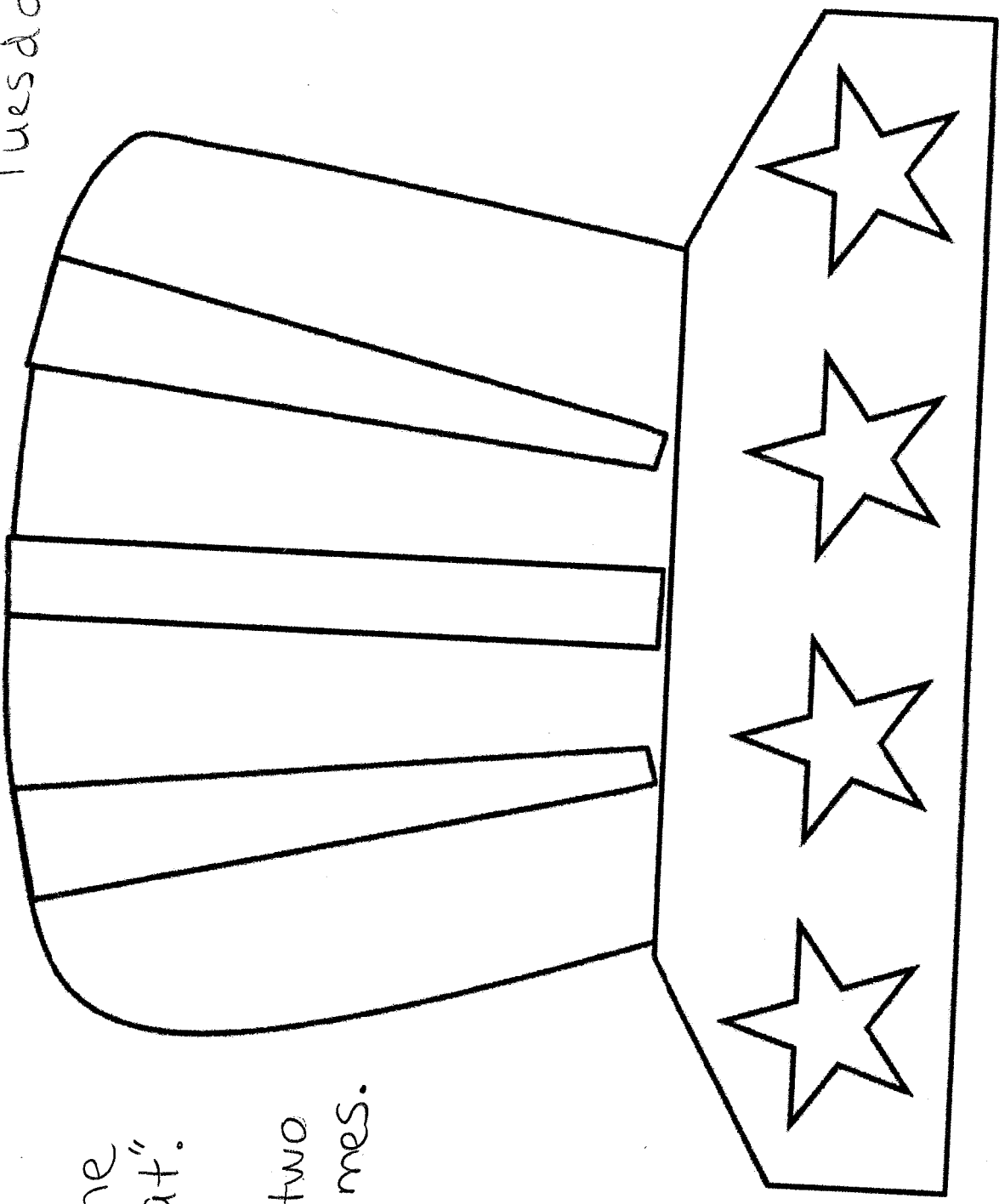

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Kindergarten! We hope that you and your child are ready for a wonderful year in Kindergarten. Below you will find all the information you need regarding homework and how to download it from the web.

Every Monday, your child's Language Arts home learning packet will be uploaded to the website. You are responsible for printing it out and having your child complete the assigned work daily. Here are the procedures:

- ❖ On Monday print out the entire package, including the homework and reading log. We will upload the homework by 1:00 pm
- ❖ If there is no school on Monday, homework will be uploaded on Tuesday.
- ❖ We check homework daily, so your child must turn in their blue language arts folder daily along with assigned work inside
- ❖ A reading log is included on the homework log and should be completed daily.
- ❖ Once the homework has been checked with a check mark or a smiley face please remove it from the folder. Please DO NOT leave checked work in the folder.

Homework is downloaded from [sis.archimedean.org](http://sis.archimedean.org). Once there, you have to click on the HOMEWORK tab. A drop down menu will appear with all grades, scroll to and click on KINDERGARTEN. Another drop down menu will appear with all the kindergarten sections. Click on your child's section and there you will find all of your child's homework in PDF format. Print out the pages and have your child complete the assigned pages as stated in the homework log.

It is important that your child complete his or her homework daily, and that they complete ONLY the assigned worksheet/s. Homework is a reinforcement of the lessons taught at school. If your child does not do their homework, they will not get the practice they need to succeed. If they do more than what is assigned, the skill may not have been taught yet. If you would like to give your child extra work, they can practice writing their first and last name, review letters/sounds/words of the week and/or read a book.

If your child can not complete their homework for whatever reason, please attach a note explaining why the work was not completed. It is important that your child do his or her best to complete the work; if they are tired or are struggling with the material, please do not complete it for them. If you complete the work for them they will not be learning the skills being taught. They will, however learn how to rely on you to complete the work and they will struggle to complete their assignments in class. For this reason, PLEASE DO NOT COMPLETE THE WORK FOR THEM. That means to DO NOT WRITE THE ANSWERS, DO NOT DRAW OR COLOR THE PICTURES, DO NOT CUT OR PASTE FOR THEM. THEY HAVE to COMPLETE the work to the BEST OF THEIR ABILITY. Write a note explaining why the work was not completed and they will be able to finish it the next day. If the teacher notices that the homework is not being completed by the child a meeting will be requested.

Your child can read the book if they are able to, a family member or older sibling can read to them also. Please be sure to complete the assignment whichever way is most convenient for you. Reading is very important to your child's academic success. Proper reading helps to improve their vocabulary, writing skills, understand and solve math word problems.
