**Instructions:** Use the word box to answer 1-5. Which is which?

1. This Fallacy is about changing someone's' argument into a weaker form with or without them realizing it and attacking that misrepresented version of the argument to claim victory.
2. This Fallacy is about what happens when someone either accidentally or purposefully manipulates the word meanings of a claim. A key term or phrase in an argument is used in an unclear way, with one meaning in one portion of the argument and then another meaning in another portion of the argument.
3. This Fallacy takes place when someone makes a judgment about a claim based only on its source and not on its factual values. The origin is all they care about. Rather than looking at the possible good qualities of the claim, the claim is either accepted or rejected by one only because of its source
4. This fallacy takes place when a person assumes that a part of something explains or captures the truth about the whole of what is being described.
5. This fallacy occurs when one reasons that something that is true for the whole must also be true its parts.
