

Greek Language Test 2 using Seesaw, **Wednesday, Nov. 18, 2020.**

Students will need to be able to:

- a) Recognize when a noun is masculine/feminine/neutral **SINGULAR** (know singular articles and corresponding endings).
- b) Recognize when a noun is masculine/feminine/neutral **PLURAL** (know singular articles and corresponding endings).
- c) Select the corresponding article for the word "one" in Greek.

NOTES:

a) SINGULAR (1):

- Masculine article (goes in front of noun): **ο**
- Masculine endings: **-ος, -ας, -ης**
- Feminine article (goes in front of noun): **η**
- Feminine endings: **-α, -η** (or **-μά** with an accent on the "ά")
- Neutral article (goes in front of noun): **το**
- Neutral endings: **-ο, -ι, or -μα** (no accent on the "α")

Singular - Table 1:

	Αρσενικό:	-ος, -ας, -ης
	Θηλυκό:	-α, -η, (-μά)
	Ουδέτερο:	-ο, -ι, -μα

b) **PLURAL (>1):**

- Masculine article (goes in front of noun): **οι**
- Masculine endings: **-οι, -ες, -ες**
- Feminine article (goes in front of noun): **οι**
- Feminine endings: **-ες, -ες** (ignore plural ending for “-μά” with an accent on the "ά" - it will not be tested).
- Neutral article (goes in front of noun): **τα**
- Neutral endings: **-α, -ια, or -ματα**

Plural - Table 2:



Αρσενικό: **-οι, -ες, -ες**



Θηλυκό: **-ες, -ες**



Ουδέτερο: **-α, -ια, -ματα**

-Singular to Plural - Tables 3a and 3b. ARTICLES AND NOUN ENDINGS (both show the same information in vertical and horizontal layouts from singular to plural):

c) *There are 3 versions of the word "one" in Greek: **ένας**, **μία**, **ένα**

A) **Masculine** = **ένας** =(one)

-This is used in place of the article "ο" before a singular masculine noun ending in: **-ος**, **-ας**, or **-ης**

Examples: **ένας σκύλος** (ο σκύλος) / **ένας χάρακας** (ο χάρακας)/ **ένας χάρτης** (ο χάρτης)

B) **Feminine** = **μία** =(one)

-This is used in place of the article "η" before a singular feminine noun ending in: **-α**, or **-η** (or **-μά** with an accent on the "ά")

-Examples: **μία γάτα** (η γάτα) / **μία μύτη** (η μύτη) / **μία μαμά** (η μαμά)

C) **Neutral** = **ένα** =(one)

-This is used in place of the article "το" before a singular neutral noun ending in **-ο**, **-ι**, or **-μα** (no accent on the "α")

-Examples: **ένα δέντρο** (το δέντρο) / **ένα πουλί** (το πουλί) / **ένα στόμα** (το στόμα)
