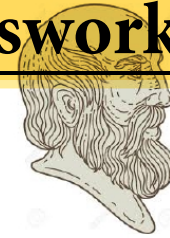

4. Would Aristotle have a problem with the idea that things change? How do changes relate to question #3?

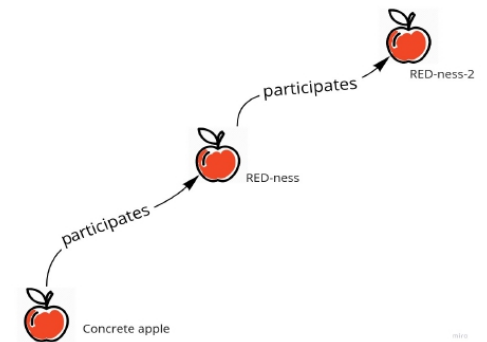


### Within Plato's Theory

**P1:** Ordinary Objects have properties

**P2:** The Forms represent ordinary objects

**C:** Therefore, the Forms have properties.



### Aristotle's Objection

**P1:** All properties have forms of themselves

**P2:** the Forms have properties

**C:** So, the Forms must have forms of themselves!
