- 2. Compare the scene in this chapter of everyone at the Buchanans to the scene in the Buchanans household from chapter one. Similarities? If so, why?
- 3. Daisy as a mom and Gatsby's reaction to her daughter. (124)
- 4. How is Daisy acting carelessly in this chapter? Why do you think she's doing this?
- 5. The parallel discovery (page 132) happening in this chapter (Tom finding out about Myrtle and then finding out about Gatsby and Daisy)- does this lead to any foreshadowing about what's going to go down?
- 6. "Her voice is full of money" analyze that section of the text as it's a famous quote from the novel. (128)
- 7. Significance of Dr. TJ Eckleberg coming up again. (130) What does it represent?
- 8. Any other moment in the chapter you feel is worth analyzing and talking about bring up a quote and talk about its importance.

Pick three of the above topics/questions and answer each with at least three sentences -- that will make it a total of nine sentences minimum.
