2. Compare the scene in this chapter of everyone at the Buchanans to the scene in the Buchanans household from chapter one. Similarities? If so, why?
3. Daisy as a mom and Gatsby's reaction to her daughter. (124)
4. How is Daisy acting carelessly in this chapter? Why do you think she's doing this?
5. The parallel discovery (page 132) happening in this chapter (Tom finding out about Myrtle and then finding out about Gatsby and Daisy)- does this lead to any foreshadowing about what's going to go down?
6. "Her voice is full of money" - analyze that section of the text as it's a famous quote from the novel. (128)
7. Significance of Dr. TJ Eckleberg coming up again. (130) What does it represent?
8. Any other moment in the chapter you feel is worth analyzing and talking about - bring up a quote and talk about its importance.

Pick three of the above topics/questions and answer each with at least three sentences -- that will make it a total of nine sentences minimum.
