transcend	to rise or go above or beyond; to exceed; to cross into a "new level" of being or consciousness
telekinesis	the power to move something by thinking about it without actually touching it; moving from a distance
superimpose	to lay or place something over something else; often used with images or videos to describe a layering effect
submerge	fill or cover completely, usually with water (to put under water), but also with other things (submerged with homework)
retroactive	being made active in the past, usually when talking about rules or laws that are written to take effect at a previous date
recede	pull back or move away or backward; retreat; also used to describe balding: "receding hair"
equilibrium	a state of balance; even distribution
equator	a line dividing a sphere into equal halves; an imaginary line dividing the Earth into Northern and Southern Hemispheres
eulogy	a speech given at a funeral that tells the good things of the deceased/dead person's life
euphoria	feeling of complete well-being, great happiness, bliss
extracurricular	outside the regular curriculum or course of study; example: sports and music are beyond the normal subjects for school
extravagant	spending, costing, or using more than is required; unrestrained or excessive feelings (extravagant love)
gigawatt	a billion watts; a very large unit of energy
gigameter	a billion meters; a very large measure of distance
hemisphere	half a sphere, especially with regards to half of the Earth; as in the Western Hemisphere
heterodox	opposed to accepted beliefs or established doctrines, especially in religion; unorthodox
heteronym	word spelled like another, but differing in sound and meaning, e.g., bass (the tone, pronounced "base") and bass (the fish, rhyming with "pass")
homogenous	all of the same or similar kind or nature (as in a group of people); or a mixture that is the same throughout (as in mixing sugar in water)
hypercritical	overcritical; too severe in judgment, finding problems in everything
hyperglycemia	abnormally high blood sugar usually associated with diabetes
hypothermia	a condition in which body temperature becomes dangerously low
immobilize	cause to be unable to move
