The project is due on Friday, August 25th.

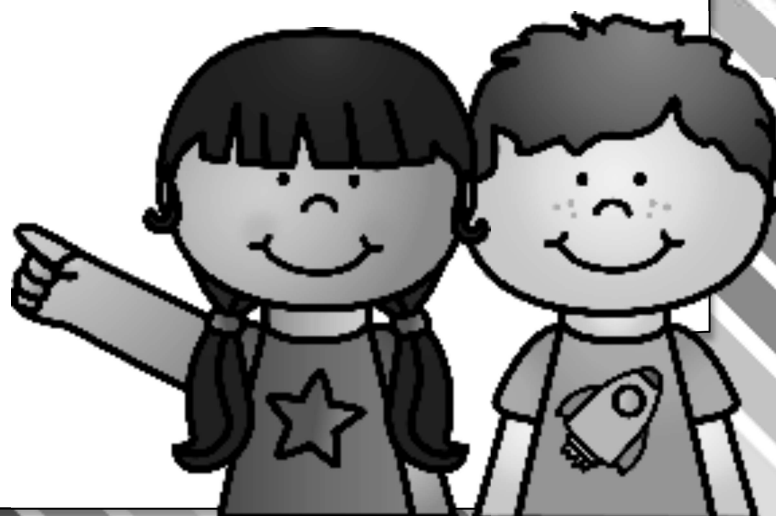
We look forward to seeing the beautiful hot air balloon projects completed!

Hot Air Balloon Craft



Assembling the Hot Air Balloons:

- Make 1 copy each balloon and a basket for each student. You may use 1, 2 or all of the balloons.
- Depending on grade level, guide students in filling out the information on each balloon and drawing a picture of themselves on the basket.
- Have your students color the balloons and the basket.
- Have students cut out balloons and baskets carefully so that they match when glued together.
- If you are using only 2 balloons, glue them back to back.
- If you are using 4, fold them in half. Glue the right side of balloon A and the left side of balloon B together.
- Now, glue the right side of balloon B to left side of balloon C, glue the left side of D to the right of balloon C, and the left side of A to the right of D.
- Your hot air balloon should look like the example.
- Punch two holes on each side of the bottom of any balloon and 1 on top of the balloons.
- Punch two holes on top of the baskets (or you can just tape the string when attaching the balloons to the basket).
- Tie the balloon and the basket together using string.



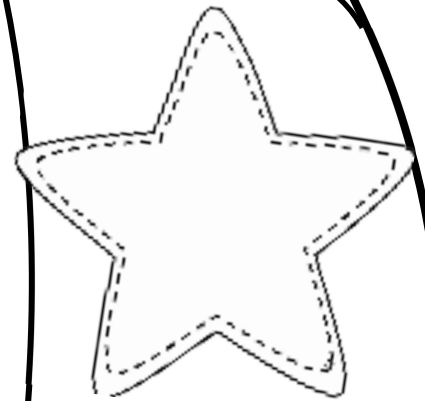
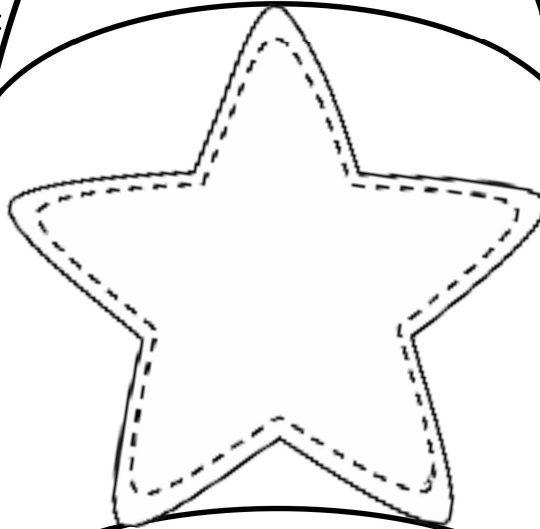
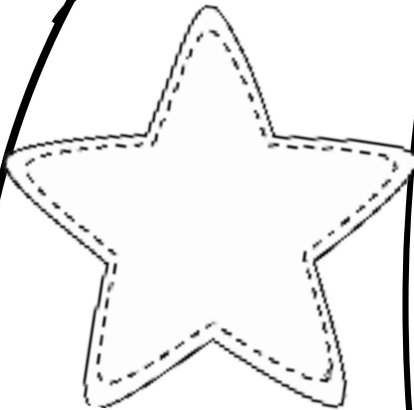
Tie a string or ribbon on top of your balloon and hang them from your ceiling. Hope you like it!

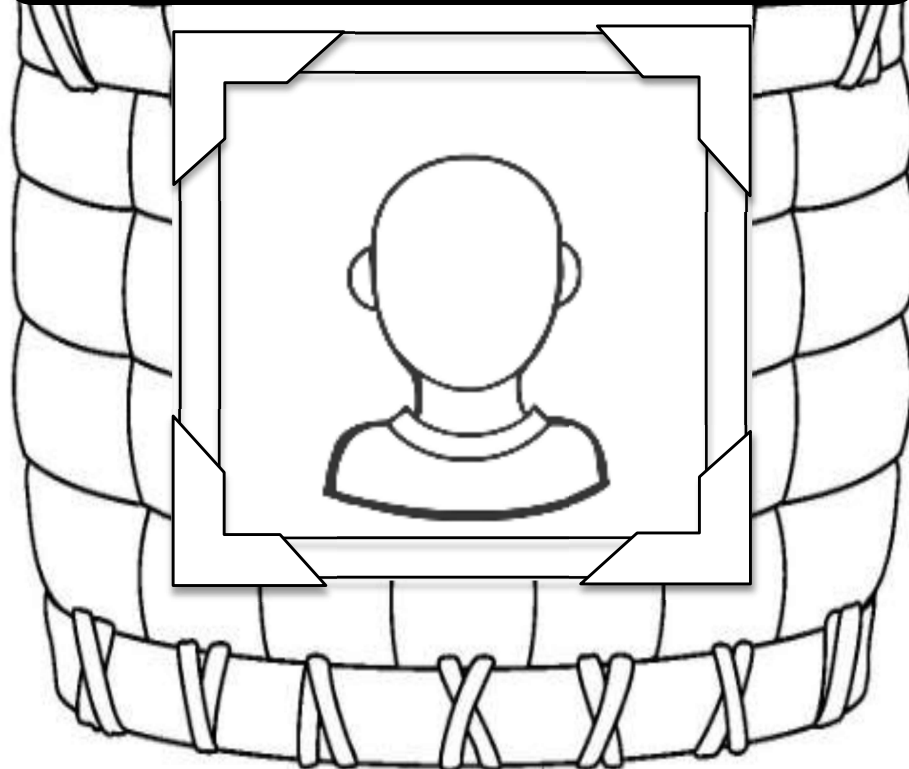
