8. How much energy consumption in US compares to energy consumption in India?

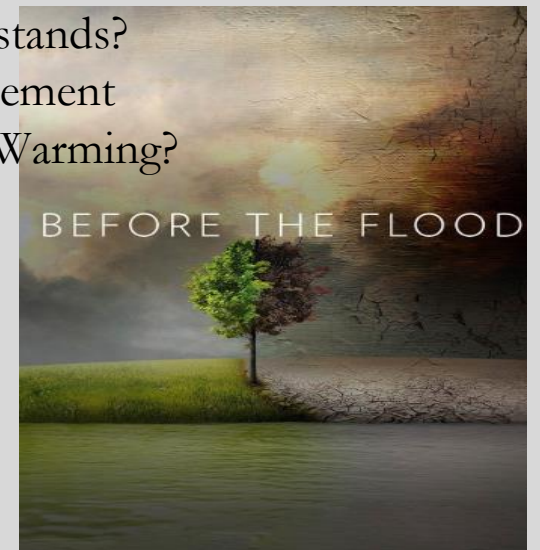
9. What is the percentage of coral reefs disappeared in the last 30 years?
