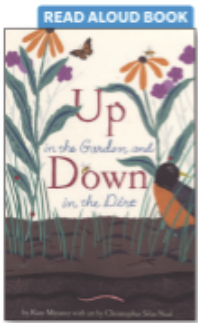

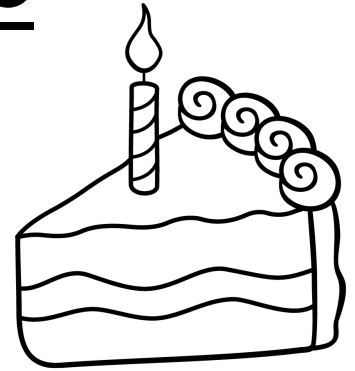

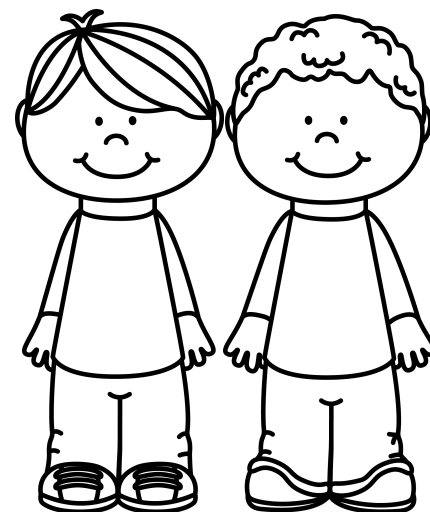

The Note

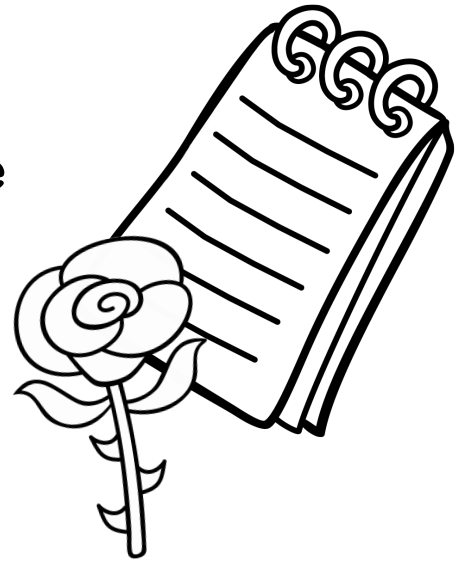
Today I broke a bone. The bone

Sam is such a good friend!



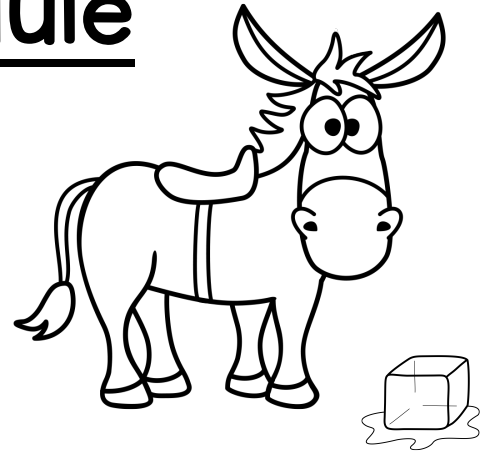
