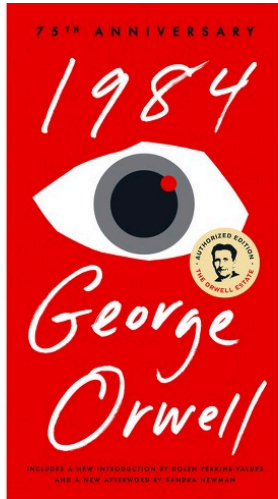

- How does technology have a negative impact on society in terms of knowledge, control, independence, and identity?
- Can we allow censorship in society, and if so, where do we draw the line? If we can't allow it, why not?
- What qualities do the two main characters possess that allow them to fight back in their respective totalitarian regimes? What sets them apart from the other characters in each novel?

Your response should expand upon all proposed questions and include direct quotations from both texts (have the author's last name and page number after your selected quote → Example (Orwell 47).).
