Vocabulary:

- **expanded form** A way to write numbers by showing the value of each digit
 $1,969 = 1,000 + 900 + 60 + 9$.
- **standard form** A way to write numbers using the digits 0 to 9, with each digit having a place value.
1,969 is in standard form.
- **word form** A way to write numbers by using words
 $1,969 =$ one thousand, nine hundred sixty-nine
