**Vocabulary words:** ( Try to remember as many as you can)

**Λ λ** το λεμόνι = to lemoni (lemon), **το** λουλούδι= to louloudi (flower)  
**το** λάδι = to lathi ( "th" like in **th**at) - ( olive oil ) (The red words are the Greek!)

Sounds : **λα** (La ), **λο** (Lo) , **λι** ( Li ) When you see (i) you read ee
