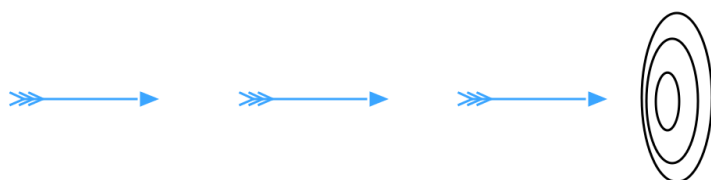
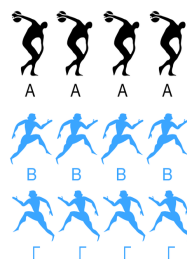
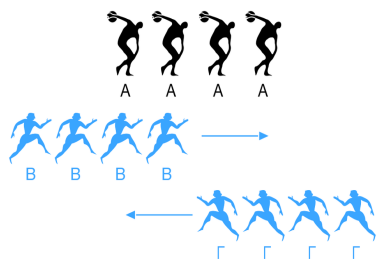
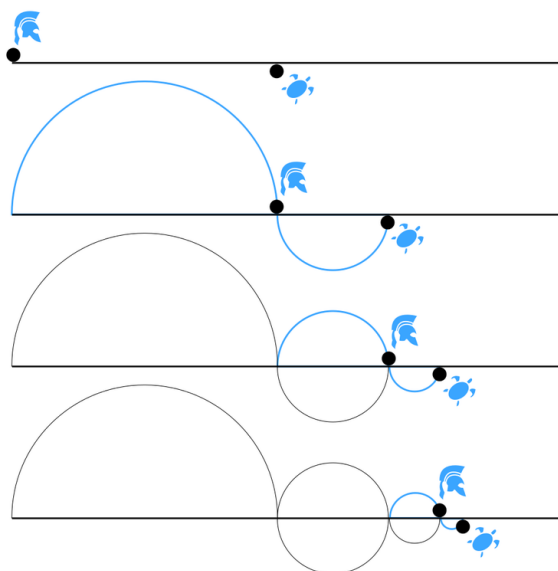
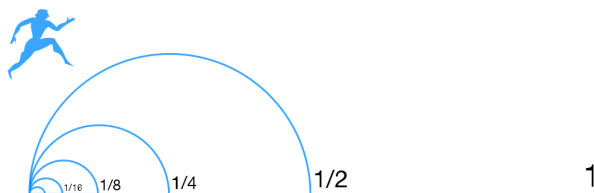
1. Circle the diagram the depicts Zeno's arrow paradox.



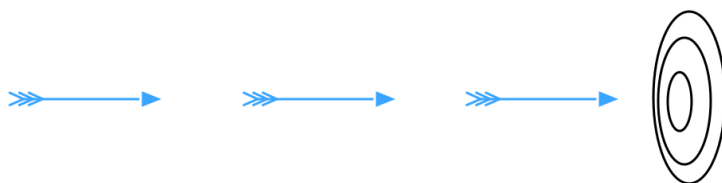
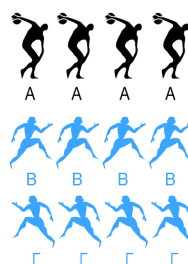
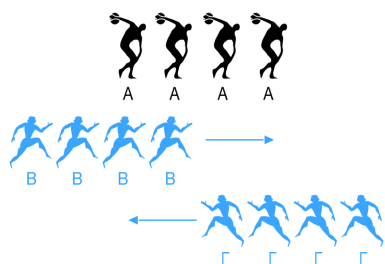
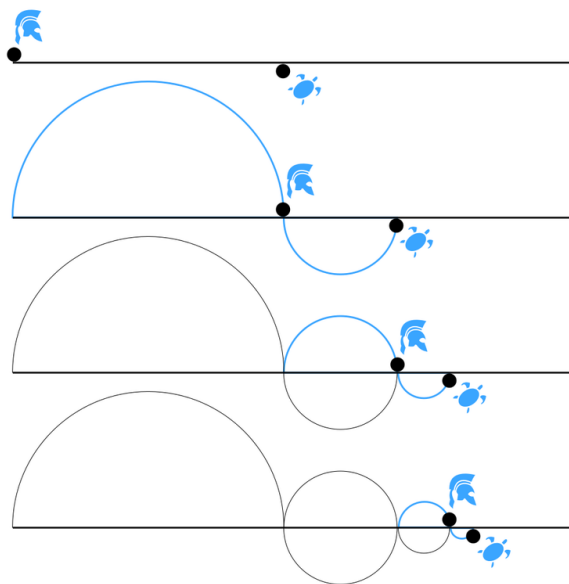
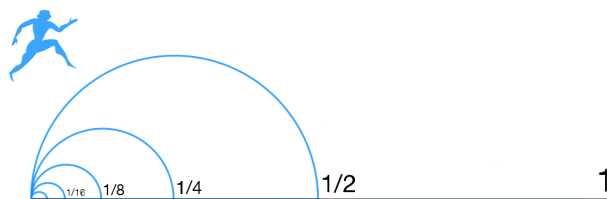
2. Circle the diagram the depicts Zeno's dichotomy paradox.
