Gorgias drew three nihilistic conclusions. To answer the following questions about his nihilism, read pages 10—18 in Unit 15.

- (i) What was the very *first* conclusion that he drew?
(Hint: It's an ontological conclusion, and he has multiple arguments for it.)

- (ii) Gorgias believed that, even if his *first* conclusion is *false*, his *second* conclusion is *true*.
What was the *second* conclusion that he drew? (Hint: It's an epistemological conclusion.)

- (iii) Why did Gorgias think that his *second* conclusion is *true*?

- (iv) Gorgias believed that, even if his *second* conclusion is *false*, his *third* conclusion is *true*.
What was the *third* conclusion that he drew?

- (v) Why did Gorgias think that his *third* conclusion is *true*?
