Authors choose **text** and **graphics** features to help **explain ideas** or to help readers **locate information**.

Bold text is darker than the rest of the text around it. It tells the reader that those words are **important**.

Diagrams are pictures with labels.




Text can be in different **colors**. The colors can **mean something** or just be for **fun!**

Text can be in different sizes.


Bigger text is usually more important than **smaller text**.





