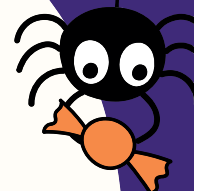




### 3rd Grade American Math HW 7

## Chapter 5: Time Measurement and Intervals

### Vocabulary

**a.m.** The times after midnight and before noon.

**elapsed time:** The amount of time that passes from the start of an activity to the end of the activity.

**p.m.** The times after noon and before midnight.
