  - i. Guidelines

      - a. Sign in to your Gmail, then go to the Apps, then click Drive, click New, then select Google Docs (if you need help finding this, ask a classmate).
      - b. NOTE: Share it with your partner, so that you can both work on it together at the same time.

    5. Organize your questions and choices, so that it looks like a teacher created it. It needs to look organized and neat.
