### What to Include on Your Trifold

**1. Physical Traits:** Describe what your character looks like:

- Age or how old they seem
- Species (human, animal, mythical creature, etc.)
- Clothes or accessories
- Any other important details about their appearance

**2. Character Traits:** Explain what your character is like on the inside/their personality:

- How do they act or behave?
- What kind of person are they (brave, kind, sneaky, loyal, etc.)?
- What are their feelings, goals, or fears?

**3. Dialogue (2 Quotes):** Choose **two quotes** (things your character says) from the book that show their personality or how they feel. Write each quote and explain **what it shows** about them.

**4. Favorite Scene:** Describe your **favorite scene** in the book that includes this character.

- What happens in the scene?
- Why is it your favorite?
- What does it tell us about the character?

### 5. Illustration

Draw or include a neat, colorful **illustration** of your character.
