- Weather- Is the state of the atmosphere at a place and time as regards heat, dryness, sunshine, wind, rain, clouds, etc.
- Types of severe weathers- hurricanes, tornadoes, blizzards, floods, thunderstorms

Water Cycle

- Collection - When water gathers in large bodies like lakes, oceans, and rivers, ready to evaporate again.
- Evaporation - The sun heats water in oceans, lakes, and rivers turning it into water vapor that rises into the air.
- Condensation - As water vapor rises, it cools and changes back into tiny liquid water droplets, forming clouds.
- Precipitation - when clouds become heavy, water falls back to Earth as rain, hail or snow.
